1. Number of places

1.1. 15 places

2. Admission requirements

- **2.1.** The following may apply:
 - a) Holders of a Master's degree or legal equivalent in the area of History or any other area in the Social and Human Sciences, with preference given to candidates with research experience in History.
 - b) On an exceptional basis, holders of a BA degree or legal equivalent, provided that they hold a particularly relevant academic or research CV and are able to provide letters of recommendation demonstrating their ability to carry out this doctoral study cycle.

- **3.2.** Applications must include the following:
 - CV
 - BA and Master's Degrees Certificates
 - Copy of identification document

- Photograph
- Motivation letter detailing the reasons for selecting PIUDHist
- General presentation of the preliminary doctoral project (title and objectives, max. 1000 words)
- Master's thesis and, if applicable, one further relevant publication, in pdf format
- Recommendation Letters

4. Selection and ranking criteria

- **4.1.** Candidates shall be ranked according to the score obtained during the selection process, based on individual merit. The following criteria shall be considered:
 - BA Degree Classification: 10%
 - Master's Degree Classification: 25%
 - Experience and ability to develop advanced research: 35%
 - Motivation letter, interview and preliminary doctoral project: 30%
- **4.2.** The final decision on the ranking of applications shall be communicated no later than one week after the closing date of the application period.
- **4.3.** Candidates shall be ranked by the Doctoral Programme Steering Committee.

Applications: 24 May - 29 June 2022

Interviews: on a rolling basis Results issued: 14 July 2022

- **5.2**. Beginning of academic year: **19 September 2022**
- **5.3.** Predicted Degree Timetable: **Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays /After office** hours

6. Application, Enrolment and Tuition Fees

- **6.1.** The application fee is €125 during the Early Bird period, €145 during the 1st Stage and €185 in the 2nd Stage, and is not refundable for excluded or non-selected candidates.
- **6.2.** The annual enrolment fee payable is €225.
- **6.3.** Tuition fees for the 2022/2023 academic year are as follows:

Year 1: 1,375€

Years 2, 3 and 4: 1,200€

7. Operation of Degree

- **7.1.** The degree shall be taught on-site, with the possibility of remote teaching.
- **7.2.** The degree shall be taught in Portuguese, with the possible the use of English where the composition of the cohort renders it possible or advisable.
