The Faculty of Human Sciences at Universidade Católica Portuguesa is currently seeking to appoint a Lecturer in English as a Second Language to enhance teaching at undergraduate and postgraduate level and to strengthen its research portfolio in the field of English Studies. The successful candidate will be expected to teach two or three courses per semester and to design course materials and assessments. This is a one-year appointment, subject to renewal. Salary: from €11,000 to €13,000 per semester for 8 hours of weekly teaching. Depending on her/his CV, after one year the selected applicant may be eligible for an increase in salary to €17,500 per semester (€35,000 per year).

To be eligible to apply, candidates will need the following:

- An MA or PhD in teaching English as a foreign language (TEFL), Culture, Translation or Media Studies;
- Applied knowledge of current research relevant to L2 teaching and learning, including familiarity with web- and video-technology;
- Excellent written and oral academic communication skills;
- Demonstrable understanding of communication requirements for students in the Humanities and Social Sciences;
- Previous experience of teaching at HE level is highly welcome.

Applicants should submit a cover letter, a CV, a sample of developed materials (print or digital) or of writing (maximum 20 pages), and two letters of recommendation.

The Faculty of Human Sciences has a strong research and teaching portfolio in Culture Studies, Media Studies, Translation Studies, Modern Languages, and Intercultural Communication. The successful candidate will be invited to join the Research Centre for Communication and Culture (CECC), a well-established Centre dedicated to scholarship and research in Culture, Media, and Translation Studies. Since its inception in 2007, the Centre has established an international reputation in its fields of expertise. Its teaching and research activities reflect the exciting changes which have been taking place over recent years in the academic disciplines of



Culture, Media and Translation Studies. The 'Católica' approach combines leading research expertise in the aforementioned areas with professional relevance.

The successful candidate will join a dynamic and innovative team from February 2023. S/he will have research experience in English Studies, Culture Studies, Media Studies and/or Translation Studies and will contribute teaching in English as a foreign language at undergraduate and postgraduate level, as well as the teaching of English for specific purposes. We particularly welcome applicants who can demonstrate excellence in research as well as knowledge of professional practice.

Applications are open from 19 December 2022. The best candidates for the role will be shortlisted and invited to present a 30-minute lecture.
