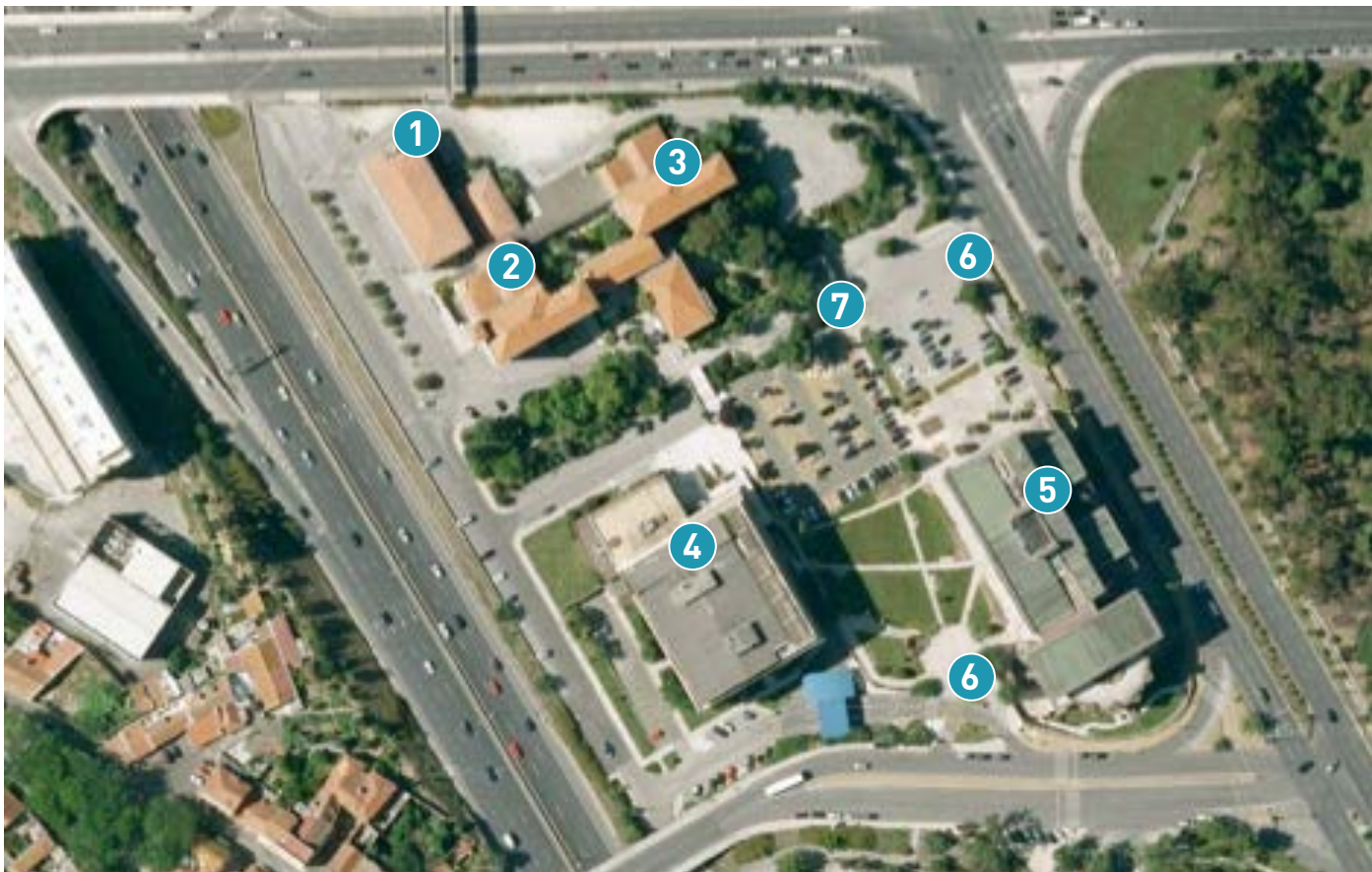

HOW TO GET HERE

This page provides helpful instructions to get to the UCP Campus in the most comfortable way. The access to the campus can be done by car, subway and bus.

Bus (Carris):

The *campus* is served by the following bus routes: 764, 755, 768 (Stop at “Universidade Católica”)

Subway:

Must leave at the station **Jardim Zoológico** (Blue Line) and walk approximately 15 min. or take buses 755/768;

Must leave at the station **Laranjeiras** (Blue Line) and walk approximately 15 min. or take bus 764;

Must leave at the station **Cidade Universitária** (Yellow Line) and walk approximately 12 min. or take bus 755, 764, 768.

OFFICE 365

The Universidade Católica Portuguesa has established a protocol with Microsoft in order to make Office 365 available free of charge to the entire Academic Community.

The access to all Office 365 services can be done with the same login and access password to the remaining Computer Services of the Headquarters.

UCP STUDENT CARD

The UCP Identification Card is the card that identifies the student, within the scope of their school activities, as well as teachers and employees of the institution.



This mandatory card, personal and non-transferable, should always accompany its holder on *campus*, identifying him at the University.

THE STUDENT CARD OF THE CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY OF PORTUGAL ALLOWS YOU TO:

- benefit from discount in the canteen and on the purchase of books at the University Bookstore;
- access spaces with entrance control;

This card may have a banking valence, offering the advantages granted by Caixa Geral de Depósitos (CGD) under the institutional cooperation agreement between the Universidade Católica Portuguesa and CGD.

SEMINAR ROOMS

HEALTH INSURANCE

• HEALTH INSURANCE EU / EEA / SWITZERLAND / UK CITIZENS

Students from the EU, EEA, Switzerland, and United Kingdom can access the Portuguese National Health System (public hospitals and health centers) by showing a valid European Health Insurance Card. You will be charged the same fee as a Portuguese citizen. The process to acquire the European Health Insurance Card varies from country to country and so does its validity period.

• ALL OTHER NATIONALITIES

A valid International Insurance is necessary to obtain a Temporary Stay Visa/Student Visa. You should check with your healthcare service provider which health units you can use during your stay. However, as a norm, you should always check what type of coverage your national health insurance provider gives you. Kindly be aware that the health insurance policy should be purchased in the students' country of origin before departure.
